

# Tribute to Little Walter to be Recorded Live



ark Hummel has been staging harmonica blowouts for over ten years. His latest show held Dec 6 at Anthology, features himself along with harp legends Charlie Musselwhite, Billy Boy Arnold, James

Harman, and Sugar Ray Norcia, backed up by the all-star band of Little Charlie Baty, Nathan James, June Core and RW Grigsby.

The concert is being recorded for a new release, *Remembering Little Walter*, on Blind Pig Records.

Known as the King of all post-war blues harpists, Little Walter, was a harmonica wizard. "His daring instrumental innovations were so fresh, startling, and ahead of their time that they sometimes sported a jazz sensibility, soaring and swooping in front of snarling guitars and swinging rhythms perfectly suited to Walter's pioneering flights of fancy." (*AllMusic*)



As a teenager he hung out with legendary heavies like Sonny Boy Williamson,

Tampa Red, Big Bill Broonzy Jimmy Rogers. He joined forces with Muddy Waters in 1948 and eventually became Waters' studio harpist at Chess records. Walter became a star of his own with the 1952 breakthrough, R&B chart-topper, "Juke." From 1952-1952 he had 14 Top Ten R&B hits including "Mean Old World" and "You Better Watch Yourself." Walter utilized the chromatic harp in ways never before envisioned and also became known for his gritty vocals.

Don't miss the chance to be part of this historic event at the Anthology. There will be two shows, 7:30 pm and 9:30 pm. Tickets at www.anthologysd.com. Hosted by Janine Harty of KSDS San Diego 88.3 FM and Blues Lovers United of San Diego. ■

# "T's" Annual Live **Anniversary Show**



# **CD** Reviews



#### COME ON HOME Teresa James and the Rhythm

#### Jesi-Lu Records

**Tramps** 

Teresa James was born to sing. She's got a powerful voice, and the skills to put it to proper use in the varied musical styles displayed on *Come On Home*, her latest

release. She and the band have delivered a solid, well-crafted and entertaining album. Several tracks are worthy of frequent airplay, which they're getting.

The album kicks off with the hard-driving Texas blues of "Come on Home to Me," followed by a vocal duet with Mike Finnegan, the Rhythm Tramps' keyboard player, on a successful cover of "If I Can't Have You." Guitarist Billy Watts stands out on the rocking "Long Way from Texas." A smoother, grooving number, "Still Got the Message," features the horns as well as the vocals and guitar. The band surprises us with a Motown sound on "She's Got a Way With Men."

Primarily rocking Texas blues, the album also includes a couple of ballads, punctuated with horns and guitar that accent, rather than dominate the tracks. Ms. James' voice is at home with all the varied styles, from the Country-Western sound of My Baby Knows What I Want" to" Voodoo Doll," a great track with a Cajun vibe.

Don't bother downloading these songs one MP3 at a time. You'll find that you should have gotten the whole album in the first place, so do yourself a favor and just go ahead and get the whole thing.  $\sim DM$ 



# DIAMONDS AND STONES

#### Jake Lear Self-Produced

Thumping, jumping, droning and rocking. *Diamonds and Stones* will have you swaying and tapping your feet, while Jake Lear sings you a song in a Bob Dylan voice, accompanying himself in a kind of slowed-down rockabilly

style. His clean guitar tone and drawling vocals take on a John Lee Hooker influence on "Jack O' Diamonds, "a track that you'll probably re-play a few times before ejecting this disk – but, wait! It's followed by a rousing, revved-up version of "Work, Work,

Work (Cut You Loose)." Yeah, you'll want to hear that one again, too. Same for the next one, "I See A Train Coming," a rhythmic, clean-toned number that might best be described as slowed-down surf blues music. On the other hand, "Boogie Time," the final track, is more of a fast blues surf instrumental. Nothing boring going on here.

*Diamonds and Stones* is a unique, engaging album that you'll be likely to keep in your play-list. You'll enjoy it the first time, and then It grows on you after that. Look for it on the CD Baby website.



#### THE ROAD TO MISSISSIPPI

#### J.P. Reali

#### Reali Records

J.P. Reali has that magic touch when it comes to playing a dobro. He is in charge, as he proves on his release, The Road to Mississippi. His guitar sings the way it should when he evokes a classic Mississippi Delta mood, faithful to original Delta style of slide guitar. He adds



some Piedmont-style tunes that have a humorous double-entendre story to tell about his "Biscuit-Baking Mama," who drinks her "Dark, Strong and Steaming" coffee every day.

The Road to Mississippi is primarily a solo album, with Reali accompanied by Mark Wenner on harp on a few of the tracks, coproducer and former Nighthawks drummer Pete Ragusa sitting in on drums on a couple, and Wenner and Reali joined by John Previtti on upright bass on the dark "Book or the Bottle."

The songs are mostly his originals, oozing with the Delta spirit that he obviously loves. His slide playing really stands out on the rousing "Bloozin' in NYC," where the influence of Elmore James clearly shines. Although he occasionally demonstrates a potential for a whispery, magical quality in his singing on some tracks, such as the thought-provoking "My Soul or Skin," his vocals don't rise to the formidable level of his guitar playing. However, they're adequate to carry his lyrics, both on his somber tracks or his amusing beer-drinking songs. "I do my share of drinking," he tells us, accompanied by Robert Johnson-style licks on his guitar, "but I never share my drink." You can imagine that this would be a real foot-stomper in front of a live audience in a little blues club. It's easy to see why he's popular with the local Washington, D.C. blues crowd.  $\sim DM$
