Rare Chance to Experience James Hunter



ailing from Colchester, England, James Hunter is a soul-man extraordinaire whose vocal chops have often been compared to Sam Cooke and Jackie Wilson. The singer-songwriter, guitarist, and cartoonist has been paying his dues in the UK since the 80s and received great support from Van Morrison, yet he remained unknown to U.S. audiences until the release of, *People Gonna Talk*, in 2006.

That recording received a Grammy nomination for best traditional blues album, though it is anything but traditional blues. His sound blends classic 60s soul, New Orleans R&B and ska in a way that makes him completely unique.

Hunter has toured extensively to support the CD, including appearances at the Doheny Blues Festival and the Legendary Rhythm & Blues Cruise. In 2008, he released his follow-up CD, *The Hard Way*, another stunning achievement. Also available exclusively on his website, www.jameshuntermusic.com, is *Live in Amsterdam*, which will give you an idea of the kind of excitement he generates onstage.

Rod Piazza & The Mighty Flyers

Don't miss Rod Piazza and his band, The Mighty Flyers, at **Humphrey's Backstage**, **July 21st**. He's always got something new up his sleeve. This will be our July Table Gig so make sure to come on in and show Rod and Humphrey's that we support the blues wholeheartedly.

Rod Piazza is a tried-and-true, dyed-in-the-wool blues veteran with credentials that are second to none. He has set a standard for harmonica virtuosity that has established him as one of the most influential living blues harp players. Piazza consistently surrounded himself with players who bring out the best he has to offer, and epitomize the very best in blues: fresh, swinging, tasteful, exciting and creative.



The core of his band has been together for over three decades, and developed the kind of musical telepathy that simply cannot exist without years of experience on the bandstand and in the studio. The Mighty Flyers are a well-oiled machine, with Piazza in the driver's seat

In the early 70s he joined forces with Otis Spann disciple Honey Alexander (now his wife) on piano, and when they formed the Mighty Flyers over three decades ago, his career really hit its stride. Since then Piazza and the Mighty Flyers have won or been nominated for just about every award that can be bestowed upon a blues band, played literally thousands of gigs around the world, recorded over a dozen highly acclaimed releases, and along the way virtually created a new style of blues - a combination of low-down Chicago grit, suave West Coast swing and jazz, and the rhythmic drive of the best early R&B and rock & roll. Quite simply, Rod Piazza and The Mighty Flyers are one of the best, most experienced, and most distinctive bands in blues today.



CD Reviews



SHO NUFF BLUES Stoney B Blues Band with Annette Da Bomb Self Produced

Stoney and his band have put together some soulful downhome style blues for ya in their latest CD titled "Sho

Nuff Blues". I put on this CD while I was cruisin on a hot summer day and I have to tell you, I was lost in time for a period of 10 tunes that simply made me wanna get my Blues groove on and let all the hassles of the day drift away. Stoney B shows us how it's done. With his special style and tone he makes that guitar talk, cry and sing to ya. Annette Da Bomb demands respect as she puts it to va in her "right between the eves" fashion. This lady definitely earned her handle as she lays it down on tracks 1, 5, 7, and 10. Papa Bob Prater on bass puts it in the pocket with a groove so deep you can't even climb out and together with Tony Peterson you can feel the hip shakin comin on. Not to be out done are Pat Kelly on keyboards and Lance Dieckmann on harmonica and vocals who add that traditional Blues element bringing it all together for what in my humble opinion is some of the best traditional Blues coming from San Diego. ~ Deb Blake

MAKE IT GOOD RJ Mischo

Delta Groove Records

Veteran harmonica player RJ Mischo doesn't rely on cover songs in serving up this well-crafted disc. All thirteen tracks were written by Mischo, himself, but there's not a filler song in the bunch. Each song stands on its own, from "The Biscuit Is Back," a track that



demonstrates Sonny Boy Williamson's influence on his harp-playing, to "Papa's S.T. Special," a hoedown number that fits right in with the high-energy dance-floor music that drives this CD. Overall, a Rockabilly meets Sonny Boy spirit pervades the album, interspersed with a classic Muddy Waters flavor on many of the tracks, such as "Minnesota Woman."

His playing style is wide-ranging. "Up to the Brim" is a standout instrumental, among many on the disk. You can hear James Cotton, Mojo Buford and other forerunners in his masterful harp playing. Mischo also delivers the vocals. His lyrics will often give you a laugh. "In All Over Again," he tells us he's got no money for groceries, because he spent it all at the liquor store last night.

He hand-selected the band members that accompany him on this new release, his tenth CD. He tells us in his liner notes, "I was at the King Biscuit Blues Festival watching a performance of Anson Funderburgh when the vision for this album came to me." Johnny Moeller and Nick Curran join him on guitar. He recruited Nick Connolly on piano and organ, Ronnie James Webber on upright and electric bass, and on drums, Wes Starr, whom Micscho calls "one of the greatest shuffle drummers working today." Jeremy Johnson also makes appearances on guitar, bass drum and high hat, and Richard Medek joins the band on drums on the title track. $\sim DM$
